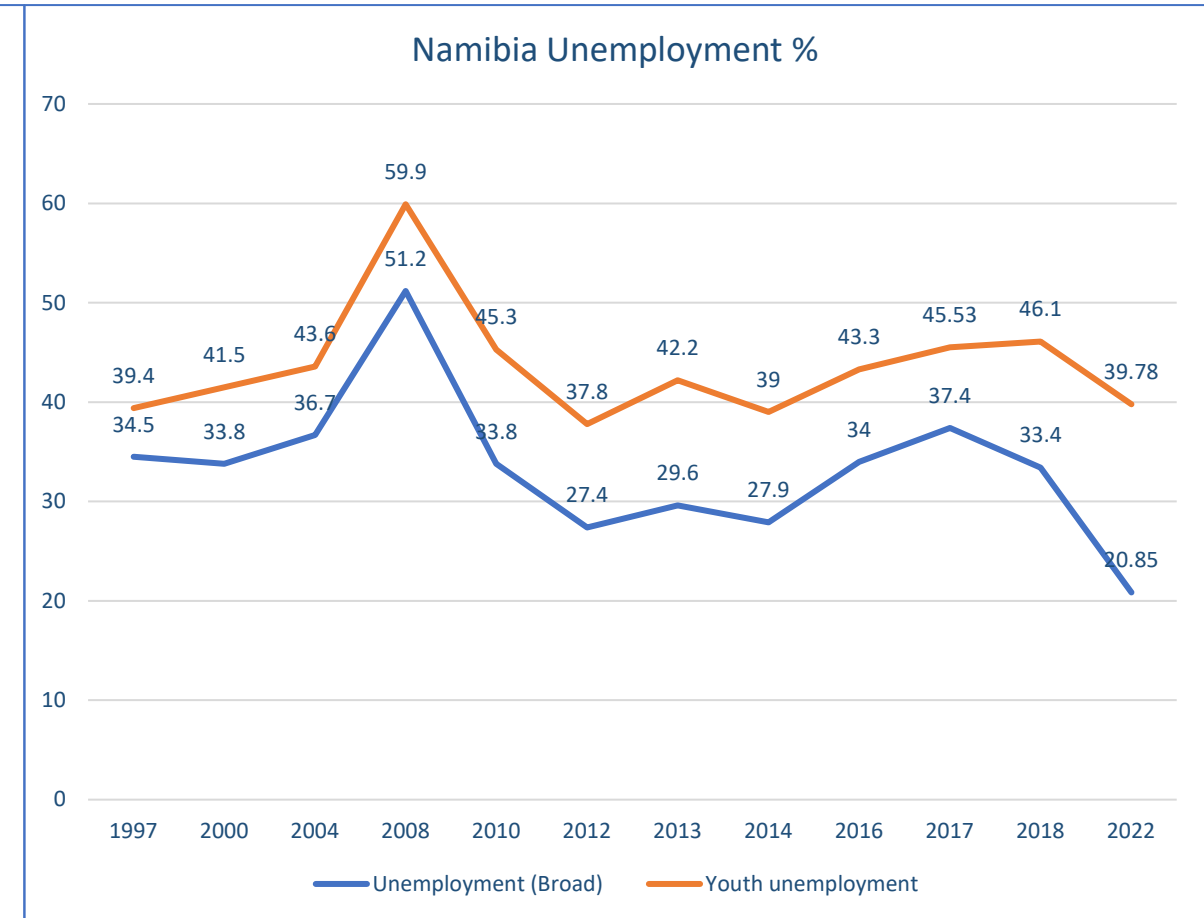

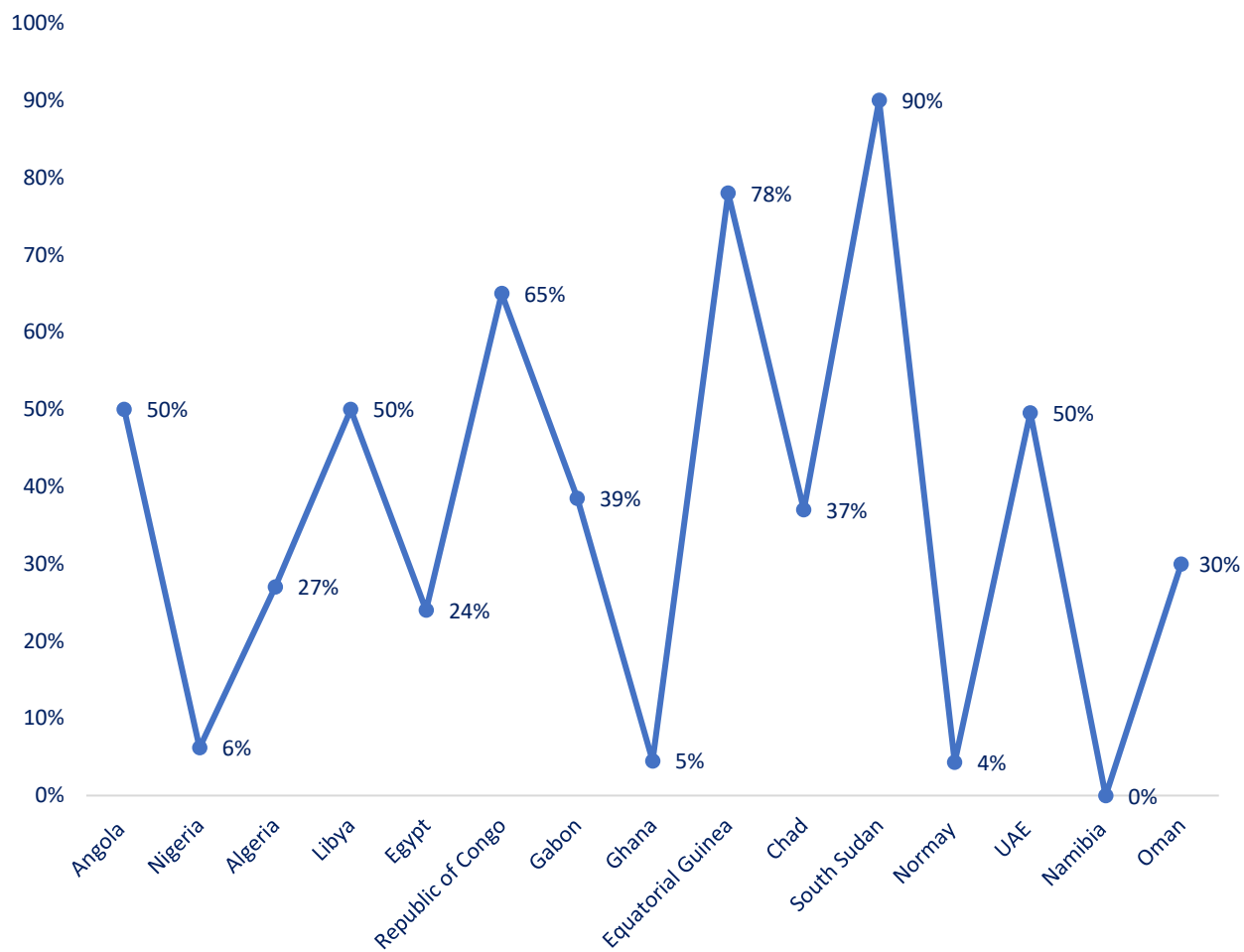

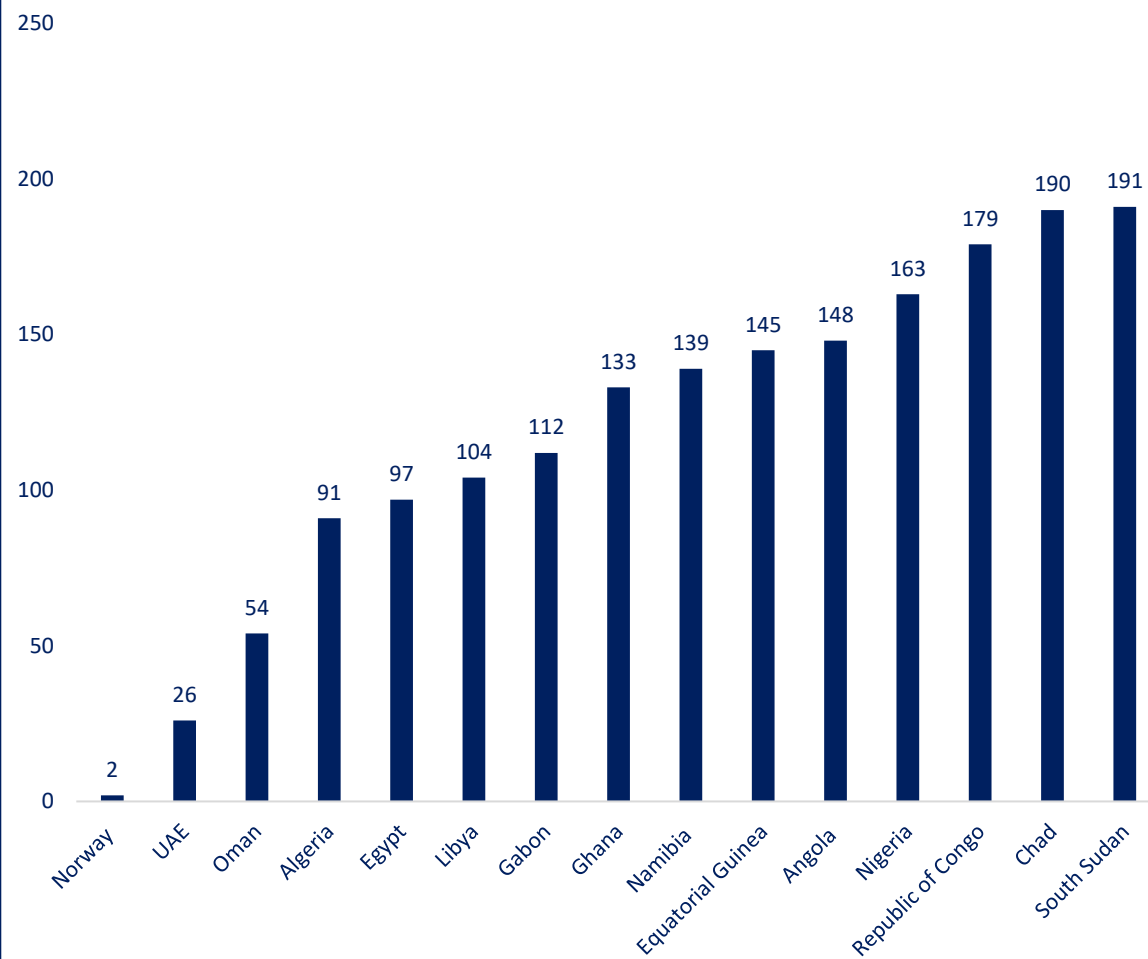

### Oil Contribution to GDP



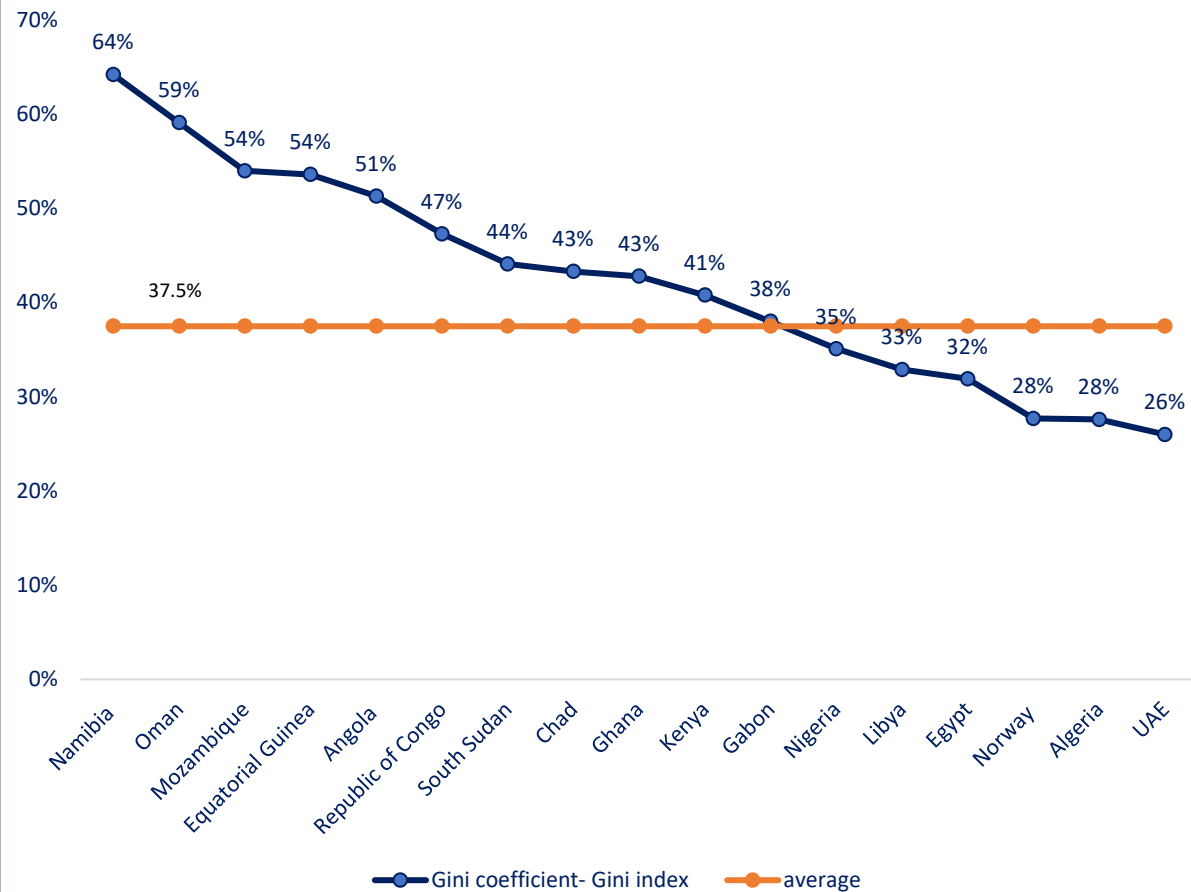

### Human Development Index- Global Ranking

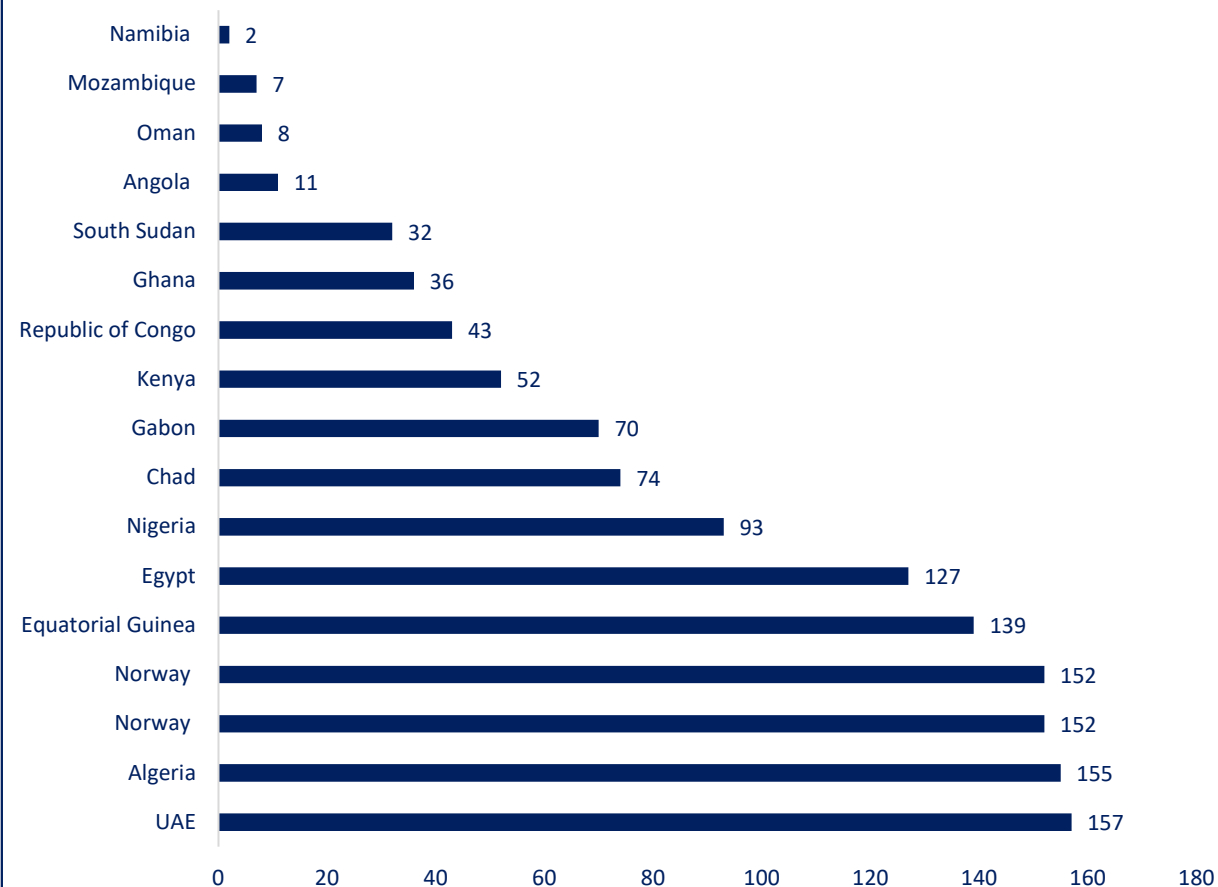

### Gini coefficient

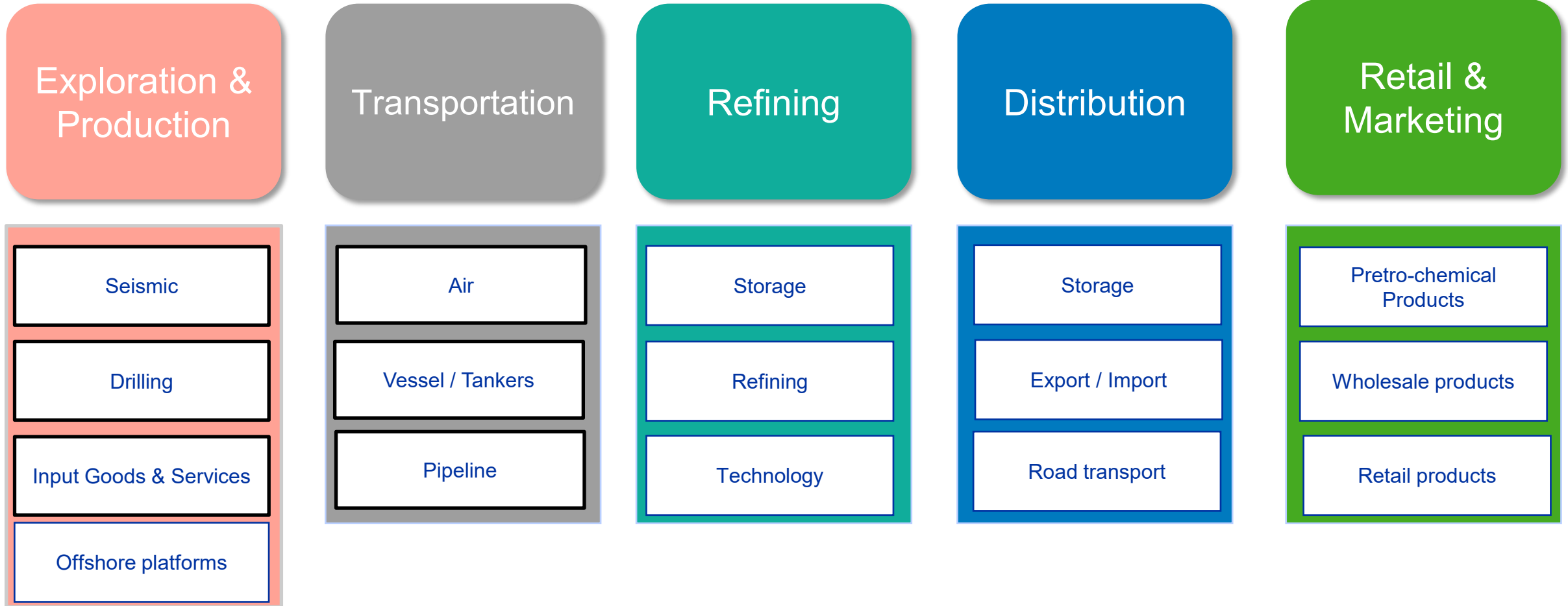


### Gini Coefficient Global ranking
