STRATEGIC

- Signature of the new Concession Contract with the Port of Luanda for **another 20 years**.
- Implementation of the SONILS 2030 Strategy, with the execution of 16 initiatives out of a total of 20, of which 5 with a degree of compliance above 90%.

HEALTH, SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT

- Obtaining ISO 14001, ISO 45001 and ISO 27001 Certifications, recognition that SONILS complies with the best practices inherent to the environment, occupational health and safety management, as well as information security management.

OPERATIONS

- Creation and development of a digital platform, tailored, with the aim of improving the efficiency of SONILS planning and operation.
- Reinforcement of the energy transition, with the connection to the ENDE public electrical network, with a capacity of 15 KV, which works in parallel with the Solar Plant with a capacity of 1 MW, allowing for savings in operating costs.

COMMERCIAL

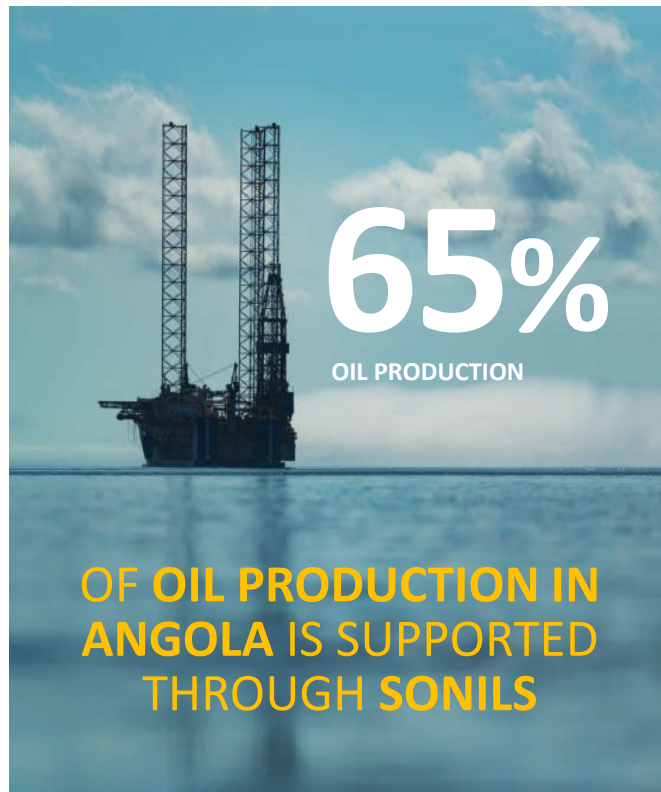
- Renewal of contracts with the main companies in the sector.

- Alignment with the main customers energy transition strategy.
- Transform SONILS business model from a logistics base to a fully integrated logistics service provider.
